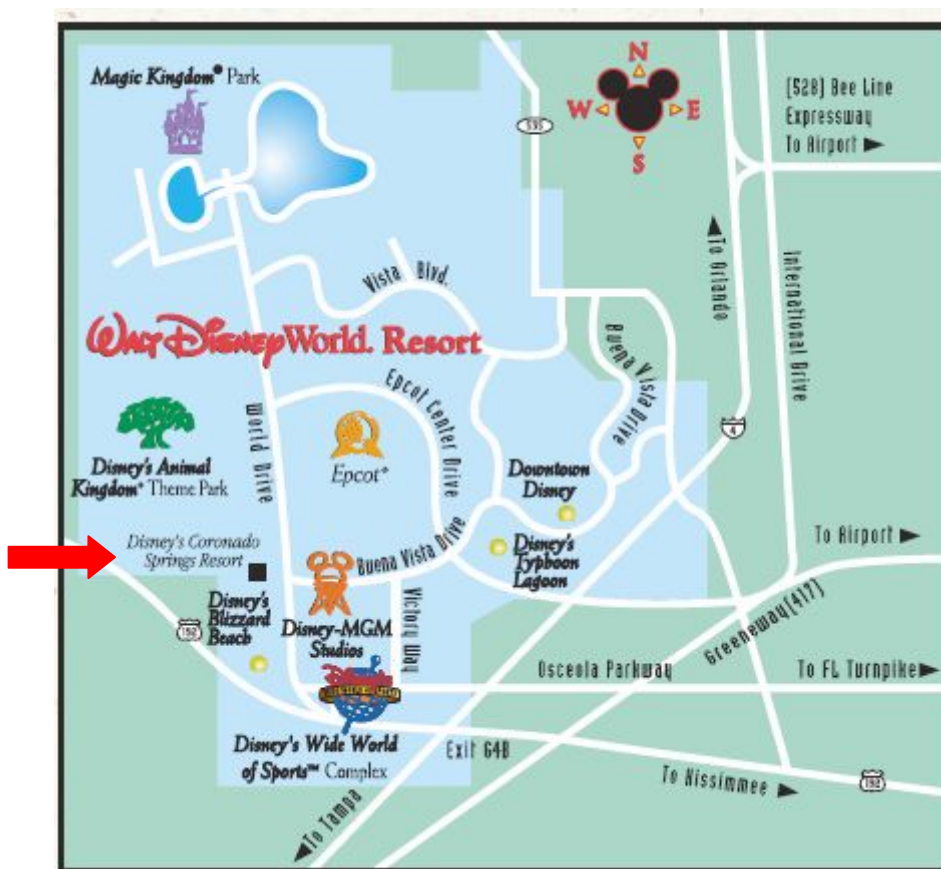

We will have representation from the mainland United States, Canada, Alaska, Hawaii, and South America. So, there will be most of the ingredients of an excellent pow wow---so please come and join us. This is a free event for all.

What is the cost of the event?

Individual Prices:

When is the vendor and exhibitor area open to the public?

Vendor and exhibitor areas will be open during all four days of the event. The schedule is tentatively Wednesday, August 20 from noon to 9 p.m. and Thursday through Saturday August 21-August 23 from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

What is happening at the Skateboarding Jam?

There is no charge for people already registered for the conference.

The public is encouraged to attend the event at Vans Skatepark, 5220 International Drive, Orlando--- and will be welcome at our Native American Cultural Festival on August 23rd.

For the Skateboarding Jam, the cost to the general public is \$20, with kids under 12 and elders 65 and over, paying \$5. The general public can pay only \$5 each, if they bring 3 non perishable food items for the Second Harvest Orlando Food Bank which is in desperate need of supplies for the mid-western flood victims, and for the State of Florida, fortifying against the upcoming Hurricane Season.
